# Covid-19 Vaccine

*Fact Sheet:*



## *About the Vaccine:*

- The Covid-19 vaccine will prevent you from experiencing severe illness due to Covid-19.
- The vaccine is given in two doses, 3-4 weeks apart. Both doses must be received to ensure the vaccine works.
- The Covid-19 vaccine does not contain a live virus and **DOES NOT** carry a risk of causing disease in the vaccinated person.

## ***Common Questions:***

- **Do I need to get the vaccine if I already had Covid-19?**

Yes. Early evidence suggests immunity from having had COVID-19 may not last very long, but more studies are needed to better understand this. However, those that had COVID-19 should delay vaccination until about 90 days from diagnosis. Consult with your doctor to best understand when you should receive the vaccine.

- **Are there severe side effects of the Covid-19 vaccine?**

Only in rare cases are there severe side effects of the COVID-19 vaccination. About 15% of people experienced short lived symptoms at the site of the injection, and 50% developed systemic reactions such as headache, chills, fatigue or muscle pain or fever lasting for a day or two. These side effects indicate that your immune system is responding to the vaccine, and that is it working!

- **Do I need to wear a mask after I am vaccinated?**

Yes. The Covid-19 vaccine has been developed and tested for its ability to prevent severe illness and death from Covid-19. It is not clear whether this vaccine will prevent asymptomatic infection and spread, so you may be able to spread the virus without feeling symptoms yourself after you have received the vaccine.

- **What do I need to tell my vaccination provider about myself?**

**If you have:**

- Allergies
- Fever
- Bleeding disorder or use of a blood thinner
- If you are immunocompromised or take a medicine that affects your immune system
- If you are pregnant, plan to become pregnant, or breastfeeding
- Received another Covid-19 vaccine
